

Notice of Race

Event: International Swedish Championship for 2.4mR

Date: 10-14 august 2016

Organizer: Motala Segelsällskap, MtSS, in association with Motala Segelklubb and Motala Båtklubb

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Swedish Competitors shall when racing follow the licensing rules for advertising as decided by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 1.3 For Swedish Competitors sailors license to The Swedish Federation shall be payed.
- 1.4 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 1.5 Competitors shall when afloat wear personal flotation devices. This rule does not apply to short-term replacement or adjustment of clothing or personal equipment, or when competitors are in the harbor. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. This changes RRS 40. A boat that breaks this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.
- 1.6 Rule 61.1 (a) (2) is changed, meaning that all boats need to display a red flag for protesting.
- 1.7 Rule 44.1 is changed, meaning that a Two-Turn penalty is changed to a One-Turn penalty for breaking rules of Part 2.

2. Eligibility requirements

- 2.1 To be entitled to participate in championships of the Swedish Sports Confederation, each competitor must comply with ISAF Regulation 19.
- 2.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 10.000.000 SEK per event or the equivalent.
- 2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

3. Entries

Entry shall be made not later than 25th of July on www.mtss.se.
Late entry is accepted, but for Swedish participants to a higher fee.
The fee shall be registrated on MtSS account BG 820-1725 to fulfil the registration not later than 25th of July.

3.2 The entry shall include the following:

The helmsman's name, address, e-mail, phone, club, sex and eventual disability The yacht's design and sail number.

- 3.3 Required fee is 1300 SEK or 145 Euro, late entry is 1600 SEK or 175 Euro, which includes the following per boat:
 - launching, hauling out, mooring, trailer parking and use of Club facilities from Wednesday 10th of August to Sunday 14th of August 2016
 - the opening ceremony, Thursday 13th of August 2016



- After sail Friday 11th to Sunday 14tyh of August 2016
- Prize giving, Sunday 12th of August 2016

Approximately 200 SEK are fees to the national authority.

4. Registration and measurement checks

- 4.1 Registrations shall be made at the race office not later than Friday 12th of August 2016 at 09.00.
- 4.2 Measurement certificate and flotation certificate shall be presented at registration.
- 4.3 In addition the following measurements checks may be taken:
 - Weight of the yacht
 - ISAF Plaque Number
 - Flotation marks on the hull as well as marks on spars
 - Manual pump, towing rope, fitting for towing rope

A maximum of 3 jibs and 2 mainsails may be registered.

4.4 Measurement checks and inspections may be made at any time at the discretion and direction of the Race Committee.

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1 The sailing instructions will be handed out at registration.

8. Racing area

8.1 The location of the racing area will be on inner or outer Motalaviken.

9. The course

9.1 Windward-leeward course will be sailed.

10. Protests and penalty systems

10.1 RRS P will apply.

11. Scoring

- 11.1 The low point scoring system of RRS A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

12. Prizes

- 12.1 Championship plaquettes and titles may be awarded if six or more boats from at least three different Swedish clubs located in more than one Swedish district have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship. The National authority's rules about who can be a Swedish Champion will apply.
- 12.2 MtSS prizes according to the number of boats entered: one prize for every five boats or part of five, until a maximum of eight prizes
- 12.3 Perpetual trophies.
